


# **Creating the Redirect Host**

## Go to 'Host'




# And click on 'Add route'







Choose 'Advanced content match'



- -Then click on 'Save'







# Creating the SMTP relay service

This step serves to accept the emails coming from Letsignit once they are signed.

Go to the bottom of the 'Advance Settings' page and then to 'Routing' settings, in 'SMTP relay service'



Click on 'add' to add a new relay service.

Follow the steps to configure:

- Name it: give it a name that indicates that the service is used to accept emails coming from Letsignit once they have been signed
- Under 'Authorized senders', choose 'Only the addresses from my domain'
- Add from the button 'ADD A RANGE OF IP ADDRESSES', the following 3 public IPs correspond to our Ip clusters: 40.66.63.89, 40.66.63.90, 40.66.63.91.
- Validate the configuration by clicking on 'Validate the setting' then scroll down the page and click save.



# Google Drive and calendar notifications cases

If you send invitations for Google Drive shares or any other email for this service, calendar notifications, using email forwarding with Letsignit, these emails will not be received and you will receive a non-delivery notification.

To overcome this, please follow the following procedure.

All notifications for Google Drive leave with a specific email address, so we will configure it as an exception to the transport rule.

Go to your Google administration console via the link https://admin.google.com.

Please go to the advanced settings of Gmail by following the steps on pages 3 and 4.

Once in the Advanced Settings, go to the 'General Settings' tab, then go to 'Content Compliance'.

Edit the transport rule for Letsignit and go to the section for adding expressions;

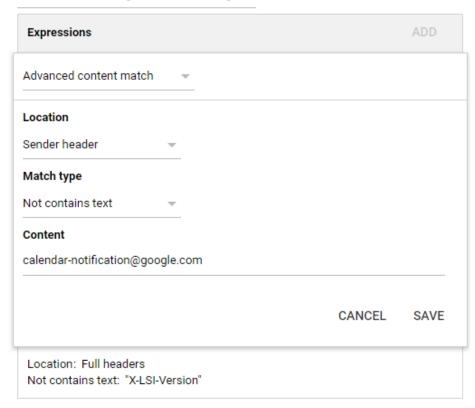

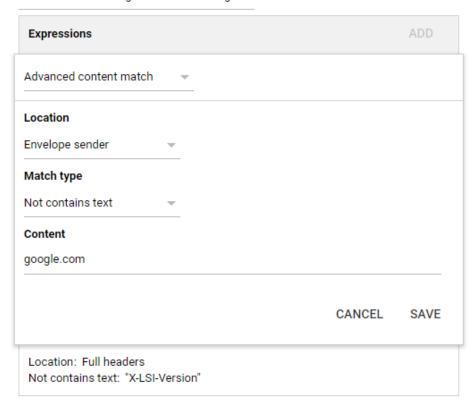
